A The Focus of the Lord's Table - Concentrated on the Lord Himself (Luke 22:19-20, 1 Cor. 11:23-25)

1 All hymns, praises, thanks, testimonies, and words should be concentrated on the Lord Himself

...Many Christians think that to have the Lord's table is to remember His death. This is wrong. We are not going to remember the death, but we are going to remember the Lord Himself. The Lord told us to do this in remembrance of Him, not of His death. We remember the Person, the Lord Himself. This is the central point of the Lord's table meeting. (Basic Lessons for the service Chapter 2, II-A-4)
